I acknowledge receipt of and understand that I must comply in all respects with the following:-

I must comply in all respects with the rules of the Whitianga Marina Society as per the WHITIANGA MARINA INFORMATION BROCHURE , BERTH LICENSE RULES and POLICIES. (For a full copy of all berth license rules and policies please refer to the policy folder in reception, with particular reference to clause 10: living aboard and clause 20: Insurance and Marina Policy 27.) Failure to comply with such Rules, Policies or instructions may result in immediate termination of this agreement requiring the Applicant to vacate the Marina within 24 hours. The Whitianga Marina Society reserves the right to change or amend said Information Brochure, Rules, Charges or Policies at any time.

On request, if failing to comply, I will vacate the marina, having first paid all monies owing.
I agree to PAYMENT OF THE FIRST MONTH/WEEK IN ADVANCE AND PAYMENT IN ADVANCE MONTHLY/WEEKLY THEREAFTER. For any reason failing to do so, I agree to pay all additional costs of debt incurred to recover any monies owing.

I also note and agree:

That I may only live on board for 6 months in any 1 year (the six months does not have to be continuous). The start date is to be when I begin living on the boat. This term is at the discretion of the Management Committee.

I will be charged an additional live aboard fee as determined by the Society.

The vessel's owners and family only to live aboard.

Absolutely **No discharges** into the Marina.

No maintenance to be undertaken that interferes with other Marina users. (Noise, dust, etc.)

No animals to be kept on board.

The vessel must be maintained in a tidy condition. (e.g. no laundry in the rigging.)

There are to be no obstructions of any kind left on the piers or fingers.

All electrical and other connections must comply with the Marina's Policy requirements (policy number 4), including electrical warrants of fitness.

There is a limit of one vehicle per live aboard vessel allowed in the Marina parking area.
